

FALLING WALLS SCIENCE SUMMIT 2021 JOURNALISM FELLOWSHIP: CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The Falling Walls Foundation is offering a journalism fellowship grant to support media representatives from around the world in reporting on the topics of the Falling Walls Science Summit 2021. Selected journalists will be invited to Berlin to meet international speakers and participants of the Falling Walls Science Summit during the physical event on 7-9 November 2021.

The Falling Walls Foundation calls for applications from journalists outlining their chosen topic relating to the interdisciplinary programme of the Falling Walls Science Summit 2021. Successful applicants will be invited to join an exchange with one of the festival's numerous renowned partner organisations and speakers. Reporting can take place before, during or after the Falling Walls Science Summit (7-9 November 2021).

Up to twenty media representatives will be selected. They will each receive a fellowship grant, provided by the Berlin Senate Chancellery for Higher Education and Research. The grant will be awarded as a lump sum and includes travel, accommodation and per diem expenses for the whole duration of the fellowship programme (6-10 November 2021) as well as research and reporting costs, if those apply. The fellowship grant aims to further strengthen the international public perception of Berlin as a location for scientific excellence and to contribute to the promotion of independent science journalism.

WHO MAY APPLY?

Applications are open to media representatives from around the world with a proven track of journalist record (freelance or permanent). Applicants are expected to research and publish on a chosen topic related to the Falling Walls Science Summit. There are no restrictions on specific media areas or the form of publication.

- Max. three examples of your journalistic work within a field of science

Travel to Berlin is required. The provided fellowship grant includes accommodation, travel and per diem expenses and event fees, excluding any further reimbursement by the Falling Walls Foundation. The Falling Walls Foundation will take over the accommodation and travel bookings and can act as an inviting organisation for visa processes.

To make the Falling Walls Science Summit as safe as possible in times of pandemic, we have decided after intensive deliberation to only allow vaccinated - with all globally approved vaccines - and recovered guests on site. In accordance with local regulations, all guests who have not been vaccinated with a vaccine approved in Europe must provide proof of a daily antigen test. We offer this test free of charge onsite. FFP2 protective masks will be provided during the event. The venues are equipped with air filtration devices and distances are maintained in situations where the protective mask is not worn. In addition, all surfaces are regularly disinfected and cleaned.
