

FALLING WALLS LAB

STAGE SETUP

The illustration below depicts the ideal international Falling Walls Lab stage setup. While you are free to arrange your stage according to your needs, the five key features below must be present.



- 1 Make sure that you have a **large screen** which allows the entire audience to have a good view of the presentations. A default slide, which needs to be on display at the beginning and end of your event, as well as during the networking breaks, is available in the organiser download section.
- 2 It is important that the jury and audience can see the **countdown clock** (available in the organiser download section). This adds to the dynamic of the event and is an important part of the Falling Walls Lab design.
- 3 The presenters need to be provided with a **presentation preview screen** so that they do not have to turn around during their presentation to see what is currently being displayed. The preview screen should also display the remaining time the presenter has.
- 4 Please make sure that a **roll up** displaying the custom Falling Walls Lab logo and partner logos is prominently positioned on stage. A generic version is available in the organiser download section. Falling Walls can also provide you with a custom version upon request.
- 5 Since some presentations will include sound, it is important to connect the technical setup to a **sound system**. The countdown clock also has integrated sounds that should be played over the sound system. The first sound will be played to indicate 10 seconds remaining. A second sound will also be played once time has run out.
