1. DESCRIBE YOUR PROJECT / ACTIVITY

Teachers continuous training on Open Schooling, collaboration and co-creation (approach, methods, tools) through STEAM projects that tackle local challenges.

2. GOAL/S (WHY?)

Immediate:

- Increase students scientific literacy.
- Potentiate students awareness of local challenges.
- To open school processes to collaboration with local stakeholders.
- Promote teachers professional development.

5. CONTENT (HOW?)

1. Certified continuous training program on Open Schooling:
 - Based on a manual of methods and tools co-created with teachers - tools on design-thinking, business model canvas, identification of local challenges, stakeholders engagement.
 - Tailored to school practices and portuguese

3. TARGET GROUP/S (TO WHOM?)

Main: teachers.
Secondary: students, school board, school staff, local stakeholders.

4. FORMAT (WHAT? E.G., BUDGET, SIZE, ONLINE/HYBRID/PHYSICAL, TIME FRAME)

1. Certified continuous training program on Open Schooling: 7 sessions - 25 hours total.
 2. Open Schooling project follow-up sessions: 12 sessions - 4 per school term (1 for each school cycle).
