# Travel

### Local Transportation

*Will transportation to/from the event venues be provided?* Information regarding provided transportation to/from the event venues will be listed in the detailed programme.

### **Public Transportation**

I need help figuring out public transportation from point A to point B in Berlin (e.g. airport to hotel). Where can I find it?

To look up how to get from point A to B in Berlin, please visit Berlin's public transportation (BVG) website: <u>https://www.bvg.de/en</u>. There, simply enter where you are, where you want to go, and what day/time you wish to travel, and the site will provide you with fare information.

#### Travelling with infants/toddlers

Please contact your local organiser and let them know that you will be travelling with your infant/toddler. They will then contact the Falling Walls Lab team in Berlin to help accommodate your needs during your trip.

### Travelling with others

#### May I travel to the finale with my spouse/family/research partner/etc.?

We want you to make the most of your time in Berlin. To fully benefit from the networking opportunities with others and take full advantage of the programme we have set up for you, we strongly recommend travelling on your own during this trip. Your schedule while in Berlin will be busy and fun, and there will be little to no time to spend with friends/family. We therefore recommend that, if you nevertheless want to travel with others, you add days to the end of your trip and discover Berlin with them after the conclusion of all Falling Walls events. Regardless, if you need to book a double room for your time in Berlin, please let your local organiser know. Falling Walls will then reserve a double room for you subject to availability. Please note that you will have to pay for the additional costs at the front desk of the hotel upon check-in.

# Presentation

#### **Presentation Title**

#### May I change the title of my presentation?

Yes, you may change the title of your presentation. However, the topic of your presentation has to remain the same, so only small changes will be accepted. The final title will be listed in various printing materials. For that reason, it should not exceed 45 characters (incl. spaces and "Breaking the Wall of"). You may submit your title change with your PowerPoint presentation. This change must be made by the submission deadline in your checklist.

#### Time

#### How much time will I have for my pitch?

You will have 3:00 min. for your pitch. Unlike at the international Labs, there will be NO time set aside for questions, so you should use the entire three minutes for your pitch. The timer will start after your presentation is announced. It is important to stick to this time limit.

#### Weather

#### What is the weather like in Berlin in November? What clothes should I pack?

You can expect an average high temperature of 8°C (46°F) and an average low temperature of 3°C (37°F). However, this is just a monthly average, and weather is famously unpredictable. Sunshine, rain, and snow are all possible in Berlin during November. Please check the weather report ahead of time and pack accordingly.
